	Parents/Carers undertake to...
Learning	set aside some time every day to talk and listen to my child and encourage my child in all aspects of learning and praise them for making an effort.
	ensure academy staff are aware of any special needs my child may have and of any temporary difficulties that may affect my child's learning.
	encourage my child to complete their homework, to do the very best they can, to put in a suitable effort into all aspects of Academy life and to ensure my child is at academy on time with what they need, (uniform, PE kit, pencil case, books, swimming kit, etc).
	attend all target setting meetings.
	encourage my child to try their best in all lessons and to speak with their teachers and mentors about their progress.
Behaviour	encourage my child to treat all members of the Academy community with respect and courtesy.
	ensure that my child goes to school regularly, on time and properly equipped and behaves sensibly to and from school.
	encourage my child to treat all members of the Academy community with consideration, fairness and care.
	ensure that Academy uniform/dress code is followed.
	actively support the maintenance of the code of conduct by encouraging my child to follow the Academy rules and to demonstrate positive behaviour.
Home, Academy, Church Links	accept and value the Christian ethos of the academy, accepting its links with the church and supporting the Academy's Christian aims whilst respecting the faith of others.
	regard all written and verbal comments about my child's progress and conduct seriously, to talk about any concerns I have, to attend parents' meetings regularly.
	attend Academy meeting regarding my child and wider issues and to support the actions of the Friends of St Mary Magdalene Academy.
	respond to Academy communications in support of my child and other students.
Equal Opportunities	encourage my child to take advantage of all the opportunities provided through the Academy.
	do all I can to help the Academy to understand my child so my child can be best helped.
	respect the Academy's equal opportunity policy.
	support the Academy's work to provide equal opportunities for my child and all children in the Academy.
Entitlement	calmly discuss with Academy staff any concerns or complaints I may have, except them to be seriously listened to and acted upon if necessary.
	get to know about my child's life at Academy.

	encourage my child to share suggestions for school improvement.
